Thank you for your email of 29 June 2018, on behalf your constituents, about Alternative Ways to Lower Vehicle Emissions.

The Government is consulting on a Clean Air Strategy until 14 August 2018. This strategy is a key part of our 25 year plan to leave our environment in a better state than we found it.

Air quality has improved since 2010 but the Government recognises that there is more to do. The Clean Air Strategy sets out how we will tackle all sources of air pollution, making our air healthier to breathe, protecting our environment and boosting the economy.

Last year the Government published the UK Plan for Tackling Roadside Nitrogen Dioxide Concentrations supported by £3.5 billion funding for air quality and cleaner transport. This includes almost £0.5 billion to help local authorities to put in place local air quality plans to deliver compliance with nitrogen dioxide limits in the shortest possible time and minimise the impacts on individuals and businesses.

The Government will shortly publish its strategy for reducing exhaust emissions from road vehicles.
